## Pricing Settings

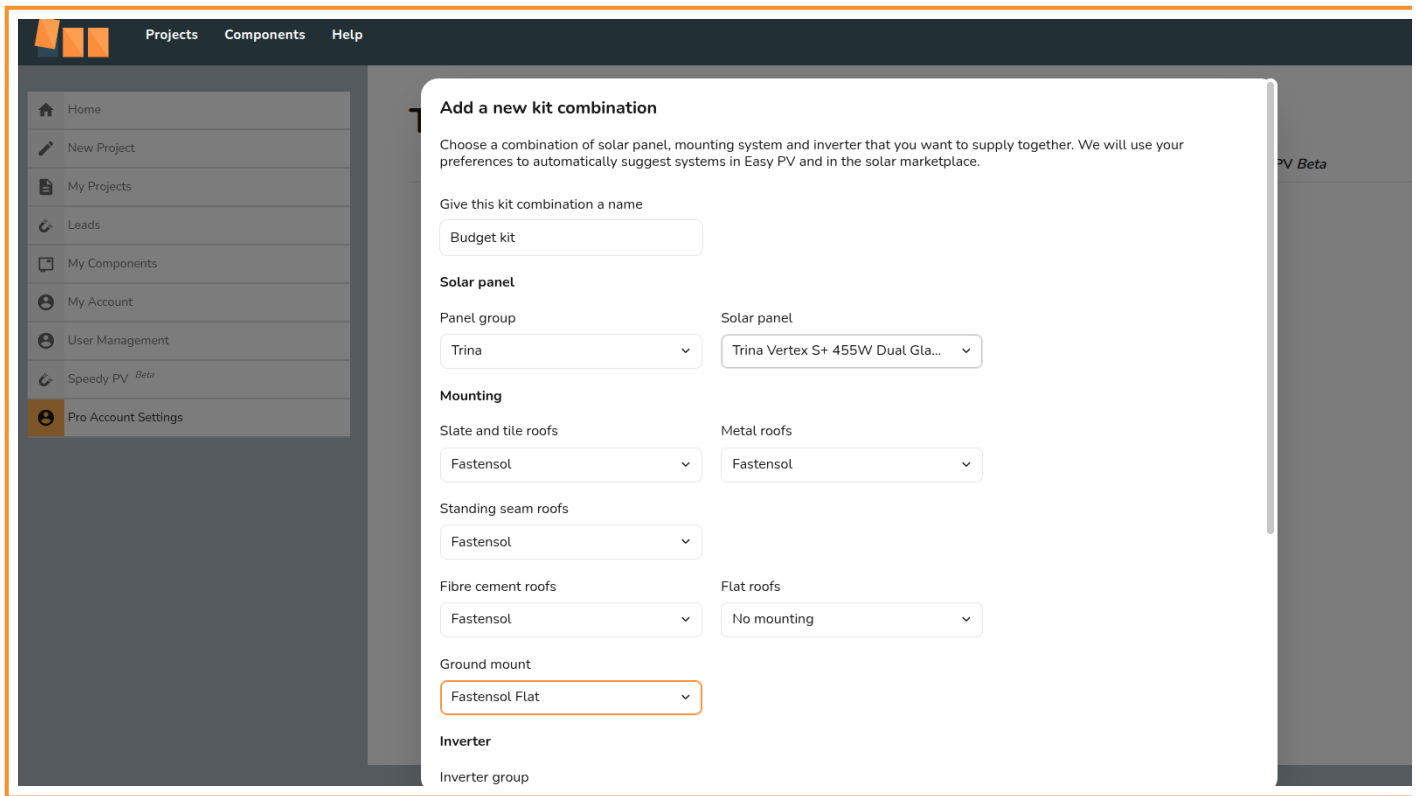

## Setting up kit combinations

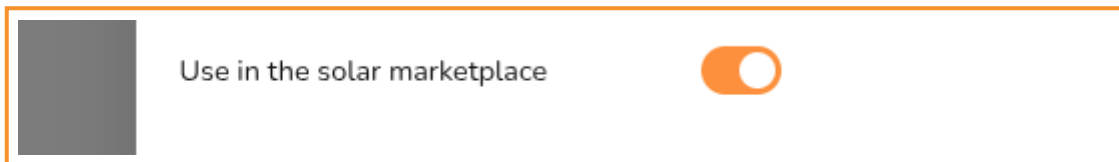
To set up the kit combinations you would like to show on the marketplace, you need to go to your Pro Account Settings > Design > Kit Combinations

Make sure to tick the box 'Use in the solar marketplace'

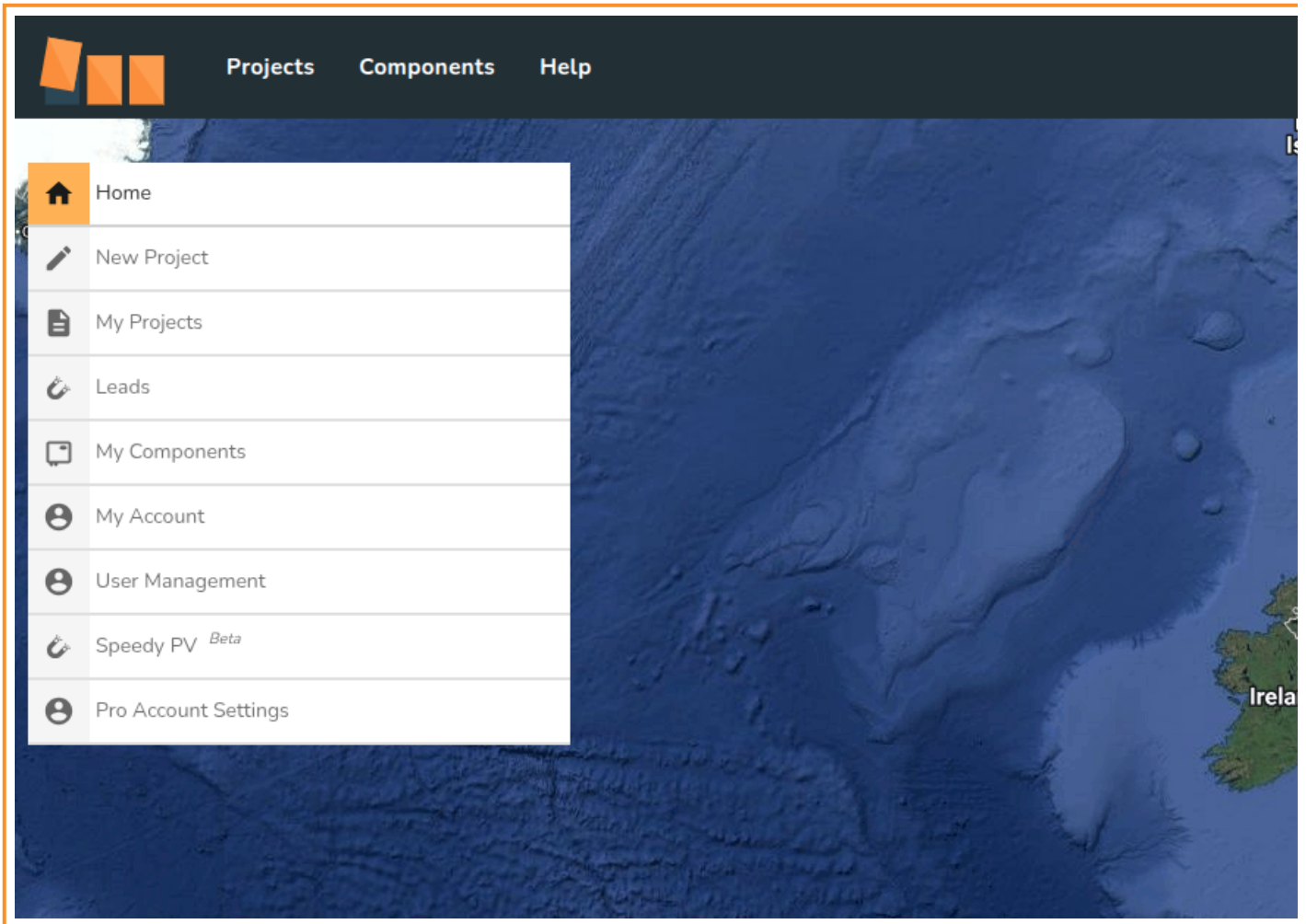


## Receiving Leads
